## Overview

GoodHire's National Criminal Databases Search searches millions of records across dozens of databases from each US state. Due to individual county and state laws, database coverage and access to records varies by state. The table below provides a summary of the available database coverage. If you know that an applicant has lived in a state with incomplete coverage, GoodHire recommends ordering county criminal court checks to locate records that are either not digitized or are in counties not covered by the National Criminal Databases Search.

## Definitions

**Administrative Office of the Courts** - current and historical felony and misdemeanor information on individuals who are or have been under the jurisdiction of the state's court system

**Department of Corrections** - felony and misdemeanor information on individuals that are or have been under the jurisdiction of the state's Department of Corrections

**County Court Records** - felony and misdemeanor criminal case information from county Criminal and Superior courts. May also include Municipal and District court records

**Other** - sources may include but are not necessarily limited to Warrants and/or other Criminal Registries
